## MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT

- An integrated treatment approach is used to meet the substance use, medical, mental health, and social needs of the patient.
- A treatment plan includes counseling, therapies, and participation in educational and interactive groups.

To enroll in the MAT Program, patients must qualify & participate in a screening process at Family Medical Center.

- Patients undergo a full health assessment to determine the severity of their substance use disorder, identify any underlying or co-occurring diseases or conditions, the effect of opioid use on the patient's physical & psychological functioning and the outcomes of past treatment. Patients are educated about how the medication works, the associated risks & benefits, and overdose prevention.

### Medications Provided

- **Suboxone** – a medication assisted treatment for opioid drug abuse.
- **Subutex**-medication assisted treatment for pregnant women with drug abuse.
- **Sublocade**- a medication assisted treatment (IM injection) for opioid drug abuse.
- **Vivitrol** – a monthly injection for alcohol or opioid drug abuse that reduces cravings and removes the reward from using. It is not an opioid replacement.

### **Comprehensive treatment on-site, which consists of the following:**

- 1. Primary Care Provider (PCP)** — Assessment and basic health care needs.
- 2. Therapist** — Biopsychosocial Assessment, weekly therapy, both group and individual.
- 3. Psychiatrist** — Psychiatric evaluation and treatment of general psychiatric conditions.
- 4. RN Case Manager** — Assessment and monitoring, referrals and connections to community resources.
- 5. Peer Recovery Coaches** – Connections to services and resources, ongoing supportive services.
